


WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS IS CLOSEST TO YOUR POINT OF VIEW?

The main reason the State supports marriage is to promote the happiness and well-being of the married couple.


STATEMENT TWO:

The main reason the State supports marriage is to help parents raise children.






In most cases, the absence of a father from the home is likely to harm a child emotionally or developmentally.






The State should support policies that encourage mothers and fathers to stay together.






I believe it is better if the parents of a child are married.






While all families should be given some support by the State, the State should nonetheless continue to support marriage over other family forms.
